Distance: 47 mile long loop, 35 mile short loop

6.5	RT	Cook Rd. (Covered bridge road on left)
6.9	LT	Miller Ave.
7.6	RT	Rt. 7 in Sheffield (stores to the right)
7.7	LT	Maple Ave (becomes County Rd.)

11.7	LT	Polikoff Rd. (and then immediately bear right on Polikoff) (option: continue to Ashley Falls for Bartholomews Cobble)
14.3	LT	Sodom Rd., after crossing 2 "Clayton Rds"

Alternative	S	Straight for shortcut to Umachenee Falls and pick up at mile 27.1 below
