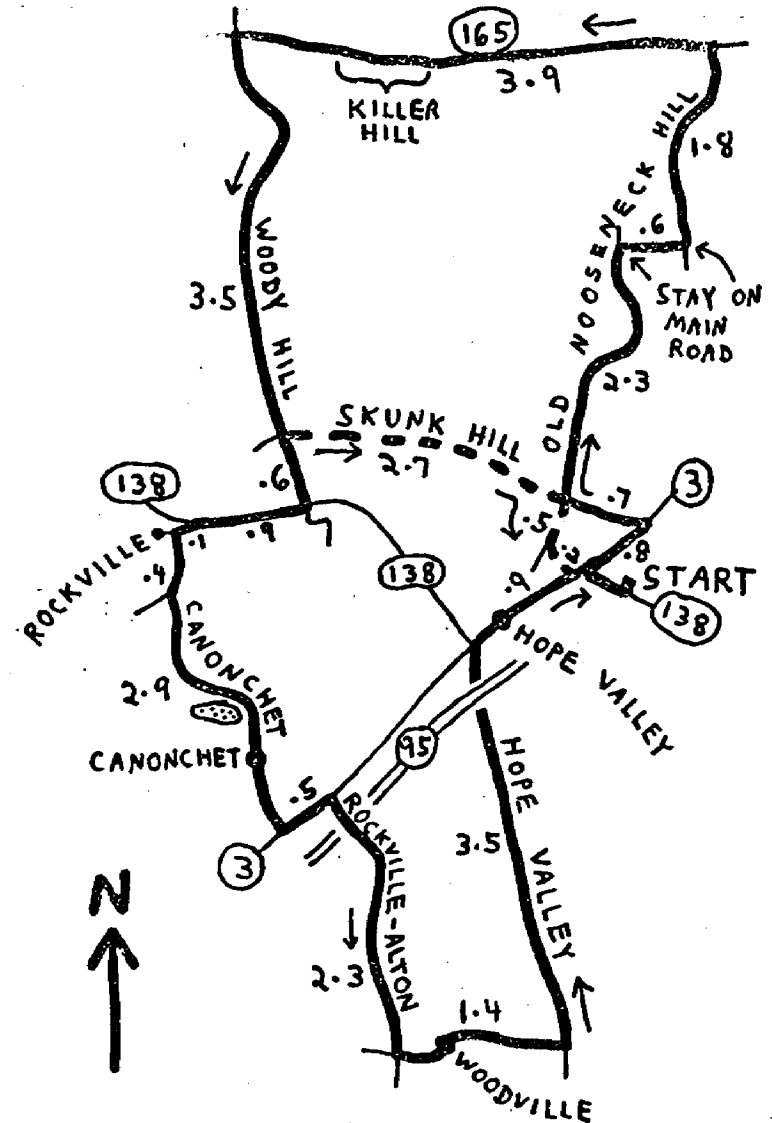
VICTORY CYCLES
Rt. 138, Hope Valley, R.I.
West of Rt. 95.

17 miles: Left on Skunkhill Rd. from
Woody Hill Rd.

27 miles: Follow map outline

SCENIC NOTES

Terrain is hilly. The notorious "killer hill" on Rt. 165 is one of the toughest, half a mile long and a 12% grade. Another steep but short hill is on Woody Hill Rd. This is a lovely ride through rural wooded terrain with a cluster of picturesque villages. Old Nooseneck Hill Rd. and Rt. 165 go through Arcadia State Park, a large unspoiled woodland area laced with ponds and hiking trails. Woodville is one of the finest mill villages in the state, with a beautiful little dam flanked by noble old wooden homes. You'll be coming downhill fast into the village, so slow down so you may appreciate this fine area.
