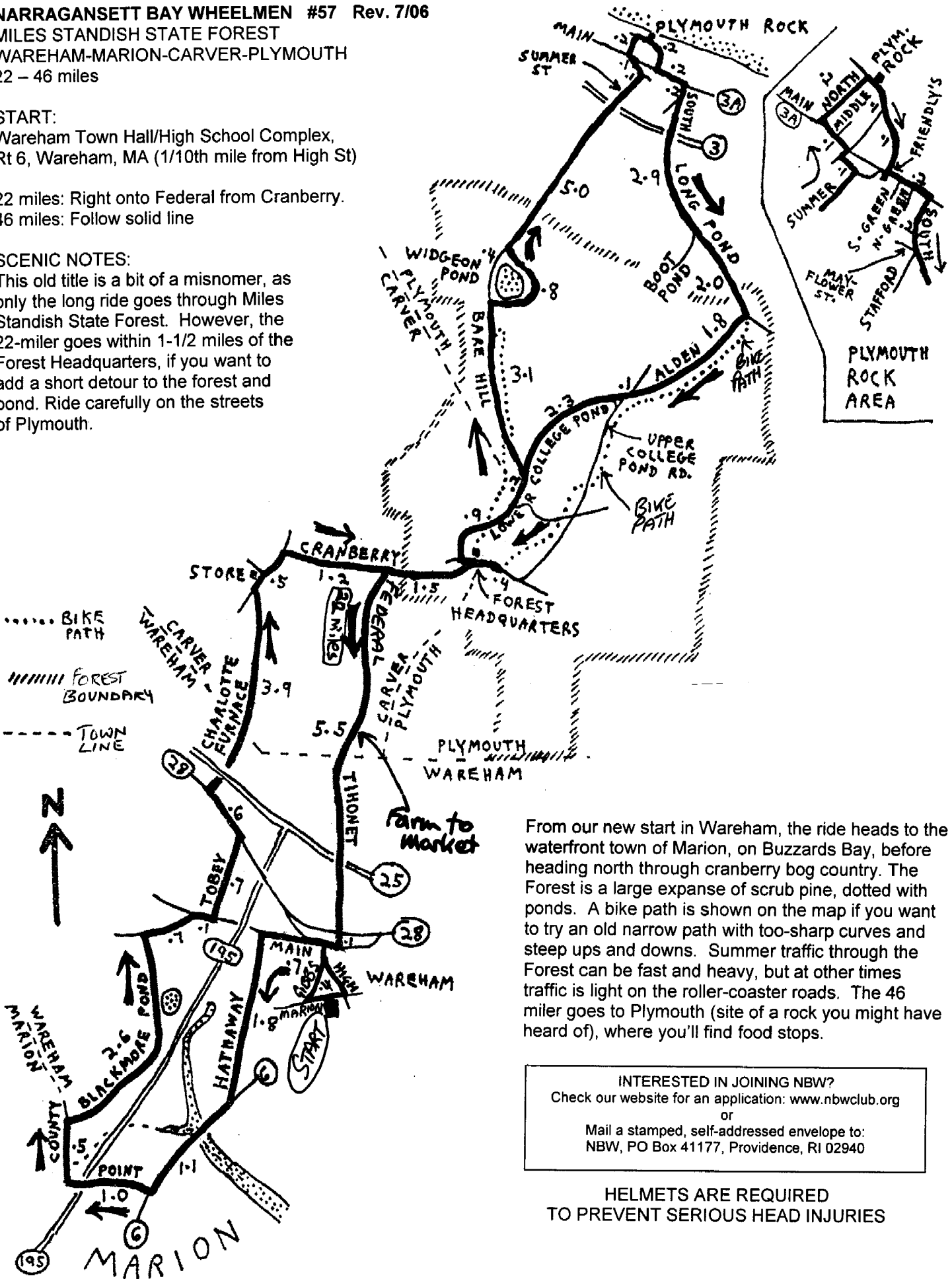


NARRAGANSETT BAY WHEELMEN #57 Rev. 7/06
MILES STANDISH STATE FOREST
WAREHAM-MARION-CARVER-PLYMOUTH
 22 – 46 miles

START:
 Wareham Town Hall/High School Complex,
 Rt 6, Wareham, MA (1/10th mile from High St)

22 miles: Right onto Federal from Cranberry.
 46 miles: Follow solid line

SCENIC NOTES:
 This old title is a bit of a misnomer, as only the long ride goes through Miles Standish State Forest. However, the 22-miler goes within 1-1/2 miles of the Forest Headquarters, if you want to add a short detour to the forest and pond. Ride carefully on the streets of Plymouth.



From our new start in Wareham, the ride heads to the waterfront town of Marion, on Buzzards Bay, before heading north through cranberry bog country. The Forest is a large expanse of scrub pine, dotted with ponds. A bike path is shown on the map if you want to try an old narrow path with too-sharp curves and steep ups and downs. Summer traffic through the Forest can be fast and heavy, but at other times traffic is light on the roller-coaster roads. The 46 miler goes to Plymouth (site of a rock you might have heard of), where you'll find food stops.
