START: SCITUATE TOWN COMMONS, N. SCITUATE, RT. 116

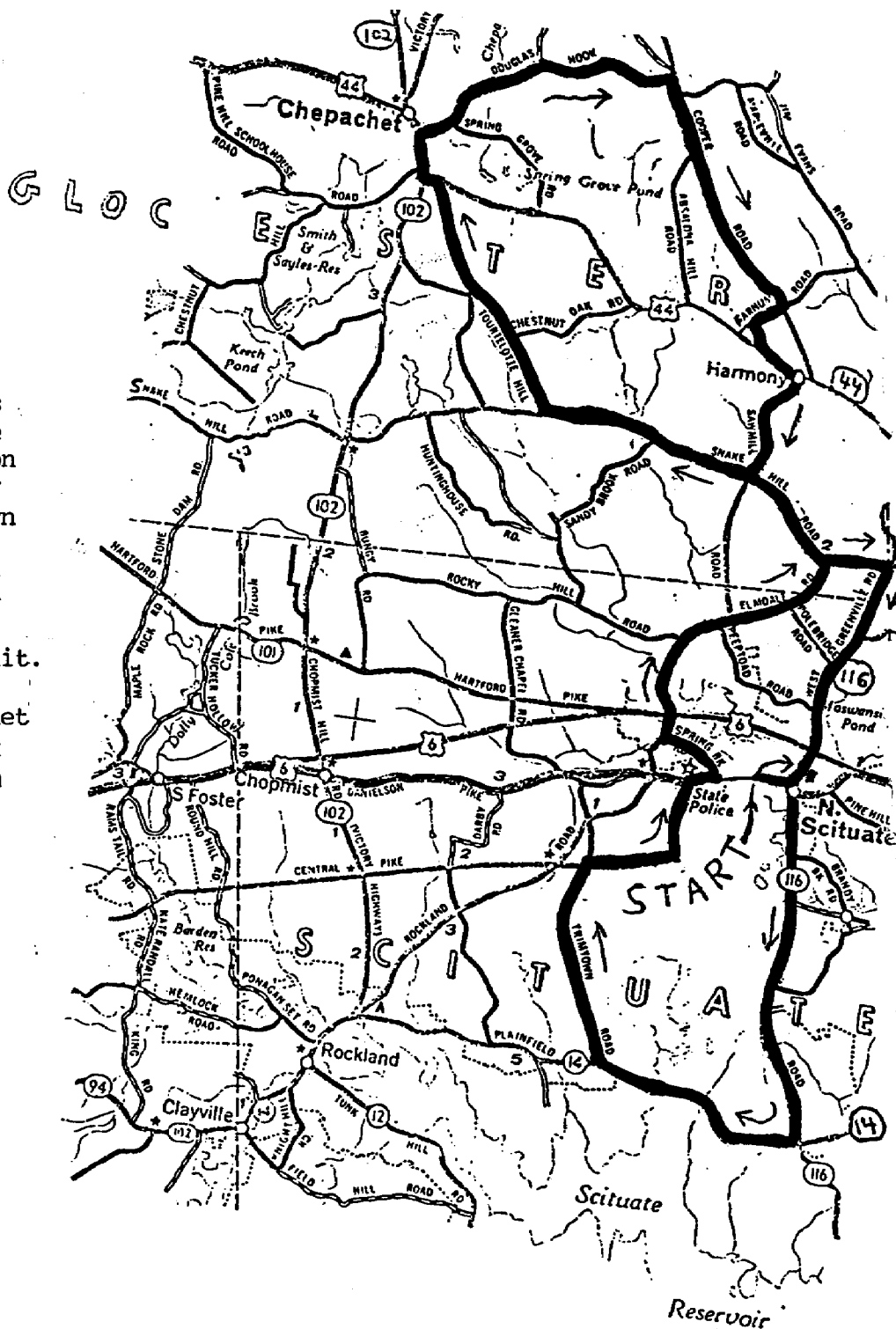
16 miles: right onto Snake Hill from Elmdale

32 miles: left onto Snake Hill from Elmdale

SCENIC NOTES

From one of our oldest NBW starting points, enjoy this northern route of the Scituate/Glouster area. The ride is not as hilly as some may expect. Opposite the common is an old white church and town library and the former site of the Watchman Institute. Every October, the town hosts the second largest art festival in R.I. A long descent along Rt. 14 leads to the climb to nestled-in-the-woods homes. Past the state police barracks along Elmdale you'll pass PeepToad Pond and enter orchard country. Stop at knights' farm for fresh cider and fruit. Skyscrapers, the amateur astronomy club is just off PeepToad Rd. The long ride heads north towards Chepachet where you will spin by Spring Grove Pond. The run back to the start takes you through Harmony by Knights Farm and by Moswaniscut Pond.
